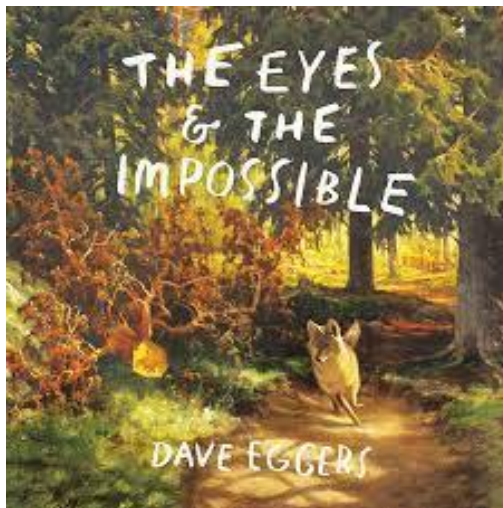


The Eyes and the Impossible
