CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

Upper School students accepted into a certificate program are expected to go beyond our college preparatory curriculum. These multi-year certificate programs provide intensive, college-level academic experiences under the support and guidance of faculty and mentors

The School of Fine Arts (SOFA) provides students a comprehensive fine arts curriculum in voice, musical theater, acting, strings and visual and digital art.

The Global and International Studies Program (GISP) develops students' overall global awareness by nurturing their intercultural consciousness and fostering the leadership skills needed to become a more active global citizen of the world.
